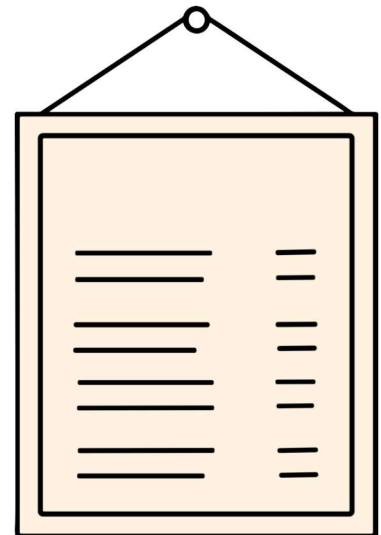

# INTRODUCTION

## THE COST OF REMAINING INTERNALLY UNSTRUCTURED
